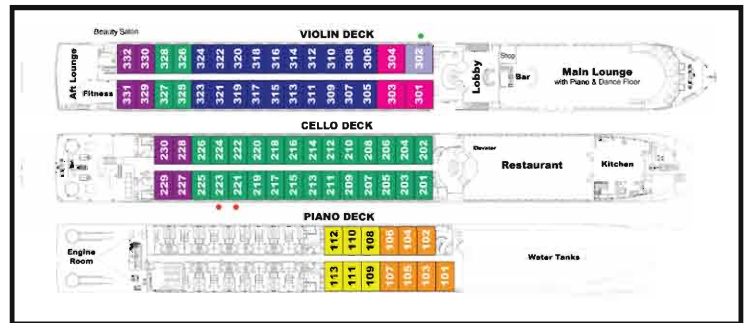

**September 9, 2012 - Sunday**

**Budapest to Krakow (B, L, D)**

After breakfast, disembarkation from AmaDolce where we meet our local tour escort at the pier. This afternoon we arrive in the city of Krakow. Poland's former capital for nearly six centuries and largest city, it was one of the few Polish cities scarcely damaged in World War II, allowing us to enjoy it in its original glory. Lunch en route at in Banska Bistrica.

Accommodation at the 5-star Hotel Radisson Blu – Krakow <http://www.radissonblu.com/hotel-krakow> or similar.



Welcome dinner will be served at Wierzynek Restaurant at the Old Town Square, dating back to the 14th century, often hosting kings – it has been spoken of as a royal restaurant. The restaurant rooms, with magnificent décor, are situated on four floors.



**September 10, 2012 - Monday**

**Krakow & Wieliczka Salt Mine (B, D)**

Half-day guided tour of Krakow, the first European city included in the UNESCO list of the most precious places of the world. Krakow is the city of humanism, whose sites capture the essence of Polish history and where the world's greatest sculptor of the Gothic, Veit Stoss, lived and worked for nearly 20 years. Our tour will take you for a walking tour of the Old Town with visit to St. Mary's Basilica to see the magnificent wooden altar by Wit Stwosz. In the middle of the square is Cloth Hall built before 1349, but renovated in the 16th century with many shopping stalls inside.



**September 10th, 2012 - Continued**

Late afternoon drive to Wieliczka to admire the underground world of 16th century salt mine. Over 700 years, many generations of Polish miners created the underground world, exceptional in its beauty, with the rich interior decoration of the chapels - including the most beautiful of Blessed Kinga, the original linings of the galleries and workings, and the underground salt lakes. The chambers are decorated with beautiful statues sculpted in salt. The Wieliczka Salt Mine is on the UNESCO list of the World Cultural and Natural Heritage. Dinner to be served at Wieliczka Folk Inn located just a few stops from the salt mine.

During your dinner a folklore ensemble will present songs and dances of the region.

Drive back to Krakow for overnight.

Accommodation at the Hotel Radisson Blu - Krakow or similar.

**September 11, 2012 - Tuesday**

**Krakow to Auschwitz to Czestochowa to Warsaw (B, L)**

Departure for Warsaw. First stop en route in Oswiecim to see the former Nazi concentration camp Auschwitz-Birkenau, the silent witness of human tragedy and the biggest 'factory' of death in the history of humanity. Afterwards, continue with stop in Czestochowa – a religious capital of Poland, a destination for pilgrimages that come from all over the world. Visit the Jasna Gora Sanctuary with the miraculous Black Madonna picture, said to have been painted by St. Luke. Also see the Treasury Room with impressive collection of many precious gifts given to the monastery throughout the ages. Lunch will be served at local restaurant. Finally continue to Warsaw for check-in at your hotel. Accommodation at the 4-Star Hotel Polonia Palace – Warsaw <http://www.poloniapalace.com/> or similar.

**September 12, 2012 - Wednesday**

**Warsaw (B, D)**

Warsaw was largely destroyed in World War II, however the historic centre has been rebuilt and has attained UNESCO World Heritage status. After breakfast enjoy a half day tour of Warsaw. Walk through the Old Town, an excellent example of a compromise between the historic values and modern needs. See the Barbican, St. John's Cathedral, Warsaw's oldest and most distinguished church, connected to celebrations of proclamation of Poland's Constitution of May 3, the first constitution in Europe and only the second in the world. Visit historical sites of Warsaw: the Ghetto Memorial, the Monument of the Warsaw Uprising, the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. Take pleasure in a drive along the Royal Route with its beautiful palaces, aristocratic residences, famous statues and historic churches. Drive to the former Warsaw Ghetto area including the site of the bunker on Mila Street, the place where the chief staff of the Jewish Combat Organization committed suicide. Afternoon at leisure. Accommodation at the Hotel Polonia Palace or similar.



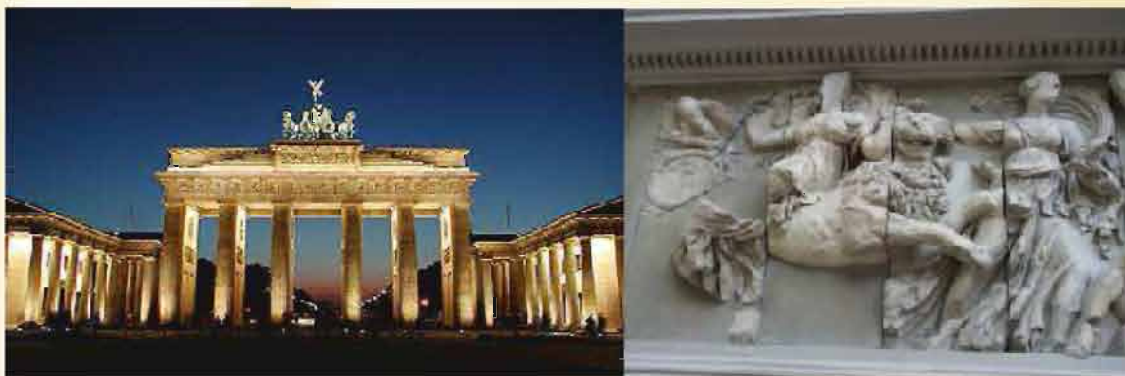
This evening we are in for a real treat – a musical journey through the world-famous compositions of Frederic Chopin, the great Polish composer whose music was inspired by the romantic landscape of Mazovia region. Following the concert dinner to be served at the Belvedere restaurant. Located in the heart of the most beautiful park of Warsaw - Lazienki Krolewskie - the summer residence of the last Polish king, Stanislaw August Poniatowski. Probably the best restaurant in Warsaw, it is housed in the historic building of the New Orangery.



**September 13, 2012 - Thursday**

#### **Warsaw to Berlin**

Early morning departure transfer to the train station to catch the train to Berlin (1st class ticket). On arrival in Germany's capital, meet with our local representative for the transfer to the hotel. Afternoon sightseeing tour including the Brandenburg Gate, State Opera House, Alexander Platz, drive 'Unter den Linden' and visit the former Checkpoint Charlie. Checkpoint Charlie was once the notorious border crossing between the Soviet and American sectors, and witness to a number of dramatic events during the cold war. Accommodation at the 4-Star Hotel Hollywood Media - Berlin <http://www.filmhotel.de/en.html> or similar.



**September 14, 2012 - Friday**

#### **Berlin to Prague (B)**

Morning at leisure. Afternoon departure to the train station for your train to Prague (1st class ticket). Arrival in Prague, meet our local representative and transfer to the hotel for accommodation. Matička Praha - 'little mother Prague' - was largely undamaged by WWII, and the cityscape is stunning. Its compact medieval centre remains an evocative maze of cobbled lanes, ancient courtyards, dark passages and churches beyond number, all watched over by an 1100-year-old castle. Another UNESCO World Heritage Site. Kidnapped by communism for 40 years, Prague has become one of Europe's most popular tourist destinations. Its traditional pubs and eateries have been augmented by a wave of gourmet restaurants, cocktail bars and trendy cafés. Accommodation at the 5-Star Hotel Intercontinental Prague <http://www.icprague.com> or similar.

**September 15, 2012 - Saturday**

#### **Prague (B, D)**

This morning we will arrange a half day city tour of Prague. A bus will take you past the State Opera, the National Museum and Wenceslas Square with its statue of St. Wenceslas. Then you will continue through Charles Square to the banks of the Vltava River, to Charles Bridge, the Rudolfinum and across the river to Prague Castle. There a walk around the castle courtyards awaits you, where amongst other things; you will have the opportunity to see St. Vitus Cathedral. This day's tour will take you through the old Jewish Quarter, known as Josefov.

Afternoon at leisure.

Evening farewell dinner and folkloric show with transfers included.

Accommodation at the Hotel Intercontinental Prague or similar.
